

The City of Tukwila has provided the following Evacuation Route Map appearing on page 2.

Sabey has added the following clarifying notes in reading the map:

Evacuation Routes Map

Please note that Intergate.East is in an evacuation route area, not an inundation area. There is no hazard posed to Intergate.East by the Howard Hanson Dam/Green River situation.

Inundation area

An area of land overtaken by the rise and overflow of a body of water.

Evacuation routes

Evacuation routes are provided to create a safe means of egress. Typically, they are:

- Wide enough to accommodate the number of evacuating personnel
- Clear and unobstructed at all times
- Unlikely to expose evacuating personnel to additional hazards

Affected or impacted areas

Areas may be designated as “affected” but have no flood hazard e.g. Evacuation routes or corridors may be affected by increased traffic as the result of an evacuation.

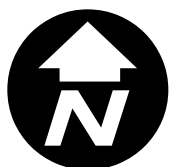
